

## Awareness counts: Space, Surveying and Spatial Diversity and Inclusion Survey

For the space and spatial sectors to be able to sustainably grow and innovate in the coming years, a diverse workforce is needed. The [Space, Surveying and Spatial Diversity Leadership Network](#) (SSS-DLN) is leveraging its network of 80-strong members to amplify and advance efforts to improve the diversity of the spatial sector.

A key outcome will be to benchmark, monitor and report on the state of diversity and inclusion to build the evidence base for action. The SSS-DLN has formed a Research Steering Committee with representatives from ANZLIC, SSSI, SIBA/GITA, SSS-DLN, Earth Observation Australian, Consulting Surveyors National and Survey and Spatial New Zealand to ensure a sector-wide approach is taken.
